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Playing online games it is very important to take care of your own safety. Saving personal data online and counteracting fraudsters is called CYBER SECURITY.

It is important to properly protect your game account from hacking and theft of game achievements.





Account protection is two-factor authentication and a good password of 8 or more characters, consisting of:

- numbers
- LARGE and SMALL letters
- special characters !)(-:()?"&

You cannot use your first name, last name, date of birth, pet name - a scammer or thief can recognize them and use them to steal your account



Now in the war time it is also very important to follow other safety rules for not to get into an unpleasant and painful situation when communicating with other children online.

Even good guys, who are usually fun and interesting to play with, can start to behave badly, offend and play dishonestly, using cheats and various traps.



Not all children understand how to behave during the war.

Many children from Russia listen to the news on TV and their parents, they don't know what is really happening in Ukraine.

Some guys can empathize. Others - can behave maliciously and create difficulties, offend.

For example, play under a similar nickname and then "hand over to moderators", use cheats and traps.

Some may form groups and specifically attack, taking away game items. And someone specifically gets acquainted in order to call names and troll.

# important rules



Rate a teammate by his game, not where he comes from Do not get into arguments about war - this can lead to a quarrel

Do not ask where you are from - so as not to provoke

If "friend" uses the word "hohol/ukrop" stop playing Don't give your
Discord to a group of
players

Don't reveal your family details until you get to know your friend well.



Whatever happens in the game - it is always important to be able to stop. Children are not responsible for the actions of their parents, but often follow their example. This doesn't mean they are bad. But the best option in this case is to pause and not play together for a while. It's better than quarrels with friends, because it used to be so great to complete game tasks together!

It is also necessary to remember that parents and relatives are always there. They are ready to help - just tell them about what is happening. They will help resolve disputes and ensure the safety of the game.

The main thing to remember is that the game should be fun, not frustrating.

Especially now, during the war. Even if you have to look for a new teammates. True friends are tested by time. Sometimes you really have to wait.
